

## Street Survey Scanning – Proposed Night Works Wednesday 20 March – Friday 22 March 2024

### The NSW Government is investing \$200 million in the Bathurst Hospital Redevelopment

As part of the ongoing planning and due diligence investigations, Health Infrastructure has engaged Usher & Co Surveyors to undertake survey scanning of the on-street areas adjoining the hospital.

The survey works will be undertaken at night, to minimise the impact of vehicles and traffic movements to scanning studies.

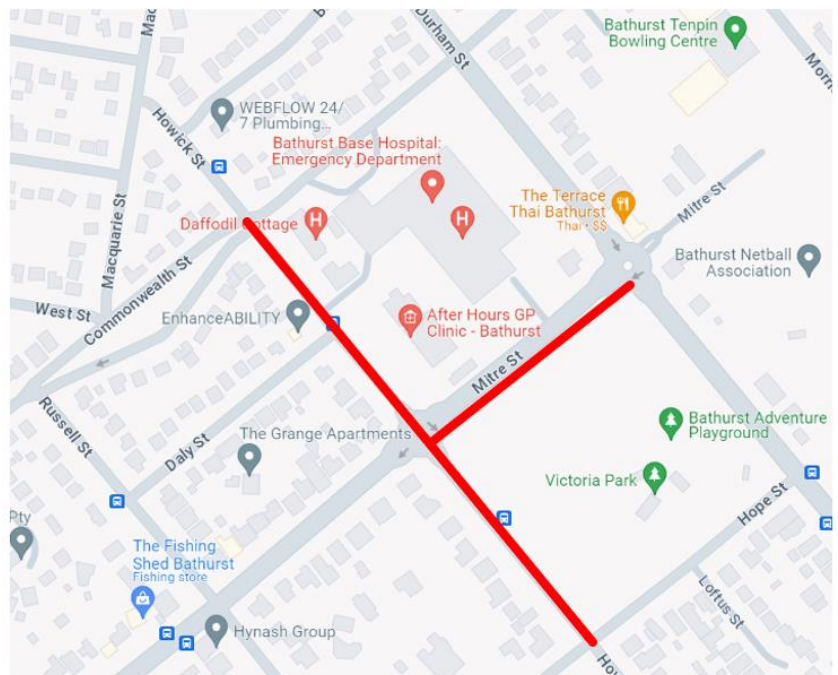
Usher & Co will undertake night survey scanning with a vehicle mounted scanner in the following areas:

- Howick Street (between Commonwealth Street and Hope Street)
- Mitre Street (between Durham Street and Howick Street)

### How will the work affect you?

The scanning will take place between 9:00pm – 6:00am (overnight) on Wednesday 20 March and Thursday 21 March, with works completed by 6:00am Friday 22 March.

Usher & Co will ensure appropriate signage is utilised to indicate the areas of work. The vehicle mounted scanner will be parked on the side of the road against the gutter for the scanning. There will be no interruption to normal vehicle flows during the scanning.
